- ☐ **Aluminum cans and steel (tin cans)**

 - o Empty and dry paint cans
- Plastic bottles marked PETE (1)
 - o Soda bottles
 - o Cooking oil

- o Mouthwash
- o Shampoo
- o Cleaners
- **Plastic bottles, tubs, or containers marked HDPE (2)**
- o Milk and juice bottles
- o Cleaners
- o Other food items
- **Hard plastic packaging and bottles marked V (3)**
- o Packaging for small electronics (must be cut open)
- **Plastic bottles, cups or containers marked PP (5)**
- o Dairy case items
- o Food containers
- o Reusable/disposable food storage containers

*NOT recyclable-Glass is currently not recyclable in our community
